

## Quality of Work

<b>A+</b>	Contribution and work produced is <b>beyond the expectations</b> of the course.
<b>A</b>	The participant is <b>continually</b> contributing to the success of the project. The participant <b>continually</b> challenges themselves to produce work of a personally high standard. The participant learns from feedback and personal reflection & observation to <b>continually</b> improve the standard of their work throughout the project.
<b>A-</b>	Some, but not all, criteria for A and some of B
<b>B</b>	The participant is <b>frequently</b> committed to the success of the project. There may be some occasional instances of distraction or lack of effort. The participant <b>frequently</b> challenges themselves to produce work of a personally high standard. The participant <b>frequently</b> learns from feedback and personal reflection & observation to improve the standard of their work throughout the project. Occasional errors in work and practice may remain evident.
<b>B-</b>	Some, but not all, criteria for B and some of C
<b>C</b>	The participant is <b>at times</b> committed to the success of the project, but lacks consistent effort towards the project. The participant <b>sometimes</b> challenges himself to produce work of a personally high standard, but this is not sustained/always evident. The participant <b>sometimes</b> learns from feedback and personal reflection & observation to improve the standard of their work throughout the project, however at times, work remains unchanged or errors recur. <b>MR or Sports Exemption, but no further effort to display quality of work</b>
<b>C-</b>	Some, but not all, criteria for C and some of D
<b>D</b>	The participant is <b>partially</b> committed to the success of the project, though displays a lack of effort towards the project at most times. The participant <b>rarely</b> challenges themselves to produce work of a personally high standard. The participant <b>rarely</b> learns from feedback and personal reflection & observation to improve the standard of their work throughout the project. Work usually remains unchanged and with consistent recurrence of errors.
<b>E</b>	Very little evidence of work completed, commitment to the project, challenging of oneself or learning from feedback and personal observation.
<b>F</b>	No work.
